Half day tour with highlights on best places to visit.

Visit Sharjah Desert Park

One of the region's great wildlife highlights, the park is home to some of the last Arabian Leopards on the planet, which are critically endangered in the wild.

There are other attractions too, with a reptile and insect house, a birds' section with a huge indoor aviary, a nocturnal section and large outdoor enclosures for flamingos, mountain goats, Arabian oryx and cheetahs, which are now extinct in Arabia but were once abundant.

For an even more hands-on experience for the kids, farm animals can be petted at the Children's Farm where there are also picnic areas and cafes.

Note: Sharjah Desert Park is closed on Tuesdays

Visit Wasit Nature Reserve

It is an important site for bird ecology within the emirate of Sharjah, it is a unique landscape with a natural lake maintained by the upwelling of underground water.

The most distinguished feature of the reserve is the diverse ecosystem since it has different habitats and types of vegetation, comprising coastal sand dunes, along with salt flat (Sabkhas) linking ponds and a large open lake.

In addition to its rich biodiversity, including 198 different species of birds, as well as the great diversity of small mammals, reptiles and insects.

Rare species of insects have been spotted, and they were recorded for the first time in the UAE.

Visit Sharjah Aquarium and Maritime Museum

With a mission to encourage the people of Sharjah and all its visitors to cherish and conserve the beauty and wealth of the oceans, the Sharjah Aquarium is a fun, unique venue with a positive message.

Opened in 2008, the aquarium offers visitors the opportunity to experience and learn about the marine environment of the UAE through its displays of a wide variety of local fish species.

Advanced technologies and cutting-edge design allow visitors to wander happily through tunnels and over bridges to gain different perspectives of the 250 species, some rare, and some just colorful, living in this beautifully constructed environment.

The Aquarium entry ticket allows you to visit the nearby fabulous Maritime Museum that sheds lights on marine life which formed a major part of Sharjah's heritage.
